# A quick look into the Thai aerospace market

Since the past few years, Thailand's aerospace sector has known a real boom. With a country's air traffic currently growing three times faster than the global market, Thailand's aircraft fleet hasn't ceased to increase, providing a boost for the manufacturing and MRO sectors. A total of 7,700 new technician and engineer jobs are expected to be created in the commercial MRO space by 2037. Thailand's MRO expenditure has been forecasted to reach a total amount of USD 10.6 billion. The Thai government is playing a central role in supporting the growth by encouraging investment in the nation's aerospace industry.
